CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) RESPONSE

MARYVILLE, MO – Due to the recommendations of the President of the United States, Governor of Missouri, and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the City of Maryville is announcing the following actions as proactive and preventative measures in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19):

- City Hall will be closed to the public following the close of business Wednesday, March 18, 2020, until further notice. Staff will remain present during business hours to support the community and are available by appointment. Please feel free to contact us at 660-562-8001.
- Beginning with the March 23rd City Council meeting, the general public will be prohibited to be physically present during meetings and bid openings. We invite you to attend virtually by viewing on live stream. A link will be placed on the City's website at www.maryville.org.
- Water/Sewer customers are encouraged to pay utility bills online at www.municipalonlinepayments.com/maryvillemo or over the phone by calling 866-955-3948. Customers may also utilize the drop box located on the front of City Hall or in the parking lot across Market Street.
- The convenience fee for online water/sewer bill payment has been waived until further notice. Customers are encouraged to minimize in person contact and use available online services.
- On March 15th, municipal water service disconnects were suspended for a minimum of thirty (30) days. Any delinquent accounts will still accrue any late fees, charges, and interest.
- The Mazingo Event Center will be closed until April 2nd. Once reopen, the facility will be limited to events with fewer than fifty (50) persons through May 8th.

- The Golf Pro Shop located at the Mozingo Event Center will be closed until April 2nd. During this time, the Sechrest 18 and Watson 9 courses will be open, walking only, and free for public use. Once reopen, tee times will be required for both courses with the use of credit card only.
- Restroom facilities at the RV Park at Mozingo Lake Recreation Park will be closed until April 2nd.
- Mozingo Lake Recreation Park staff will enhance cleaning procedures for park facilities and cabins. Full refunds are available for rentals by contacting 660-562-2323.
