The Council of the City of Maryville, Missouri, met in a special called session on Friday, January 18, 2019, at 11:30 pm, at City Hall, 415 North Market Street, in said City.

ROLL CALL

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Martin and roll was called by the City Clerk, with the following present to-wit: Mayor Martin, Council Members Matt Johnson, Tye Parsons, Benjamin Lipiec. Councilman McDowell was not present.

Others present were City Manager Greg McDanel and City Clerk Sheila Smail.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION FOR ONE (1) MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL

The City Clerk presented a bill, Bill No. 2019'04 for an ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, APRIL 2, 2019, IN THE CITY OF MARYVILLE, MISSOURI, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING ONE (1) MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARYVILLE, MISSOURI, FOR A THREE (3) YEAR TERM; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO MAKE DUE NOTICE OF SUCH ELECTION AS PRESCRIBED BY LAW, TO THE COUNTY CLERK OF NODAWAY COUNTY, MISSOURI.

December 11, 2018 thru January 15, 2019 was the period designated as the filing period for citizens interested in becoming a candidate for the one (1) position on the City Council. The election for the position will be held on April 2, 2019.

One person filed for the opening, which was William Tye Parsons who currently serves in the position of which the term is set to expire. Mr. Parsons was sworn into office on January 14, 2019 to complete the term previously held by Renee Riedel. Mr. Parsons meets all qualifications to be considered as a candidate for City Council.

Staff recommended approval of the ordinance providing for a general election to be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2019, for the purpose of electing one (1) member of the City Council.

Upon motion duly made, said bill was read by title on the first reading, a copy of said bill having been made available for public inspection by filing the same in the office of the City Clerk more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting, and was duly passed by unanimous vote.

Upon motion duly made, said bill was read by title on the second reading, a copy of said bill having been made available for public inspection by filing the same in the office of the City Clerk more than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting, and was duly passed by unanimous vote.

Motion was made by Councilman Lipiec, seconded by Councilman Johnson to approve the ordinance providing for a general election to be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2019 for the election of one (1) City Council Member. Upon roll being called the vote was as follows: Councilman Parsons, yea; Councilman Lipiec, yea; Councilman Johnson, yea; Mayor Martin, yea. Motion carried.

Said bill was then identified as Ordinance No 8160 and was duly passed, adopted and was thereupon signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Clerk.

ADJOURNMENT

Motion was then made by Councilman Lipiec, seconded by Councilman Johnson, to adjourn the meeting. Upon roll being called, the vote was as follows: Councilman Lipiec, yea; Councilman Johnson, yea; Councilman Parsons, yea; Mayor Martin, yea. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned.
